Over 1.5 mn first-time voters included in Raj electoral roll

JAIPOUR: The state has added 1,54,564 new voters between 18 and 19 years of age since the Rajasthan elections held on November 25 last year. The new voters, constituting 1.9% of the total registered voters, are eligible to exercise their franchise in the upcoming Lok Sabha elections, chief electoral officer (CEO) Praveen Gupta said.

would continue even after February 9, said Gupta. Those who are yet to register can get their names added to the electoral rolls. The supplementary lists would be updated till 10 days before the last date of nomination for the Lok Sabha elections.

Thiruvananthapuram was 9.29 in the last election. Similarly, the voter population ratio increased to 89.4 against last year's figure of 81.0.

Electors Photo Identity Cards (EPIC) have also been issued to all voters, added Gupta. He said after the 2023 assembly elections, there has been a net increase of 29,386 voters in the electoral roll. After the publication of draft lists, during the Special Shortlist Revision (SSR), 2024-updated recently, 7,30,807 voters were added to the list, while 24,15,641 names were deleted. Thus, there is a net increase of 29,624 voters.

The data was reported in the final publication of the state's integrated voter lists of 199 assembly constituencies. CEO Gupta said the election department published the final electoral rolls on Thursday in all the districts, except Karanapur assembly constituency. The final publication of voter lists of Karanapur will be out on February 11.

According to the electoral roll, 57,29,805 people with disability have been registered till now. Also, 1,28,59,960 voters in and above the age of 80 years have been registered. In the assembly elections last year, 59,04,425 people with disability and 1,17,28,0 in and above the age of 80 years were registered.

According to the voter list, minimum 47,479 voters are registered in urban assembly constituencies, followed by Jaipur (9,60,011), Sanganer (1,59,072), Vijayvihar Nagar (5,56,831) and Malviya (1,18,147).

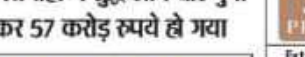
